Current expenditure on regular education system increased in 2012

According to Statistics Finland, current expenditure on the regular education system increased by 1.8 per cent in 2012 compared with the previous year. Current expenditure on the regular education system totalled EUR 12.1 billion in 2012. Expenditure on comprehensive school education constitutes the biggest proportion of the current expenditure on the regular education system. Expenditure on comprehensive school education was EUR 4.4 billion in 2012. The next biggest proportions were university education and research, on which EUR 2.3 billion was expended, and vocational education on which EUR 1.7 billion was spent.

²⁾ Calculatory employers' contribution fees for pension funds on municipal teaching personnel have been added to the figures in the years 1995–2000. In 2000–2012 also includes comprehensive school and upper secondary general education arranged in folk high schools.

³⁾ Expenditure on vocational and polytechnic education does not include small outlays.

⁴⁾ Includes universities' external financing for research. Due to changes caused by the amended Universities Act, the data from 2010 onwards are not fully comparable with those on earlier years. Includes rents of the State Real Estate Board for only part of the year 1995. The figures for 2010 exclude transferable appropriations for universities' operating expenditure and for universities' joint expenditure.
